Jack Gallagher is the Chief Executive Officer and principal owner in gTANGIBLE Corporation (CAGE 5ST11), a service-disabled veteran-owned small business (SDVOSB) that provides tangible results to its Government clients. Formed in late 2009, gTANGIBLE has experienced significant growth and success. It currently has three business lines: 1) National Security Programs Support, 2) Program, Administrative, and Management Support Services, and 3) Mission and Warfighter Support. The company provides government contracting support for the Department of Defense (US Air Force, US Army National Guard, and US Navy), Department of Homeland Security (currently supporting the United States Coast Guard), Department of State, and the Intelligence Community (National Reconnaissance Office). gTANGIBLE’s prime contracts include/have included: DHS PACTS II, GSA 84 (Law Enforcement and Security Services), USAF 53d WG’s Information Assurance and Systems Security, USDA/OCIO/ASOC COMSEC Support, and Navy Seaport-e.
